Manderson, WY, Police Department is seeking a full-time police officer for the town. Duties will include patrolling the town and enforcing state laws and local ordinances.

This is a multi-year grant-funded position with a focus on police-based response to persons in crisis. The successful candidate will be community-policing oriented. A background in crisis response is helpful but not required.

Manderson is located at the base of the Bighorn Mountains, a short drive from Yellowstone National Park and with access to fishing and recreation on the Bighorn River.

Basic qualifications include:

- 21 or older
- High school diploma or GED
- No criminal history and clean driving record
- Completion of full background check

Certification is preferred but not required. If not certified, MPD will pay for attendance at the Wyoming state law enforcement academy, including wages and expenses to and from Douglas.

Compensation includes salary (DOE), medical/dental/vision insurance (100% paid for employee; family insurance available at employee's cost), paid time off, and a take-home vehicle. Participation in the Wyoming State Retirement System is pending. We have brand new patrol vehicles and up-to-date equipment.
