Manderson, WY, Police Department is seeking a full-time police officer for the town. Duties include patrolling the town and enforcing state laws and local ordinances. MPD is a small, professional department with a focus on community policing.

Manderson is located at the base of the Bighorn Mountains, a short drive from Yellowstone National Park. The area offers access to fishing and recreation on the Bighorn and Nowood Rivers, hiking trails, boating, hunting, open spaces, and western history. This job would fit with an individual or family that enjoys outdoor activities and wants to be involved in community activities, and for those seeking a slower-paced rural lifestyle.

Basic qualifications include:

- 21 or older
- High school diploma or GED
- No criminal history and clean driving record
- Completion of full background check

Certification is preferred but not required. If not certified, MPD will pay for attendance at the Wyoming state law enforcement academy, including wages and expenses to and from Douglas.

The Manderson PD welcomes applicants with a range of backgrounds. Desired experience and qualifications include a current law enforcement certification, military service, and/or community service. We value well-rounded individuals of high character from all walks of life.

Compensation includes salary (DOE), medical/dental/vision insurance (100% paid for employee; family insurance available at employee's cost), paid time off, a take-home vehicle, and participation in the Wyoming State Retirement System (with generous employer contribution percentage). We offer ongoing training for all officers, both virtual and in-person. We have new patrol vehicles and modern, up-to-date equipment.
